

Galloway Cattle and Little Farmhands




Years ago, I decided that one of my high school science research papers and projects would center around older breeds of cattle. I put a lot of time looking into many different breeds, but there was always one that stood out and I kept coming back to it: *Galloway*. There was just something about them that I knew would be the right fit for my goals, and any, at that time future, little farmhands that would hopefully come my way.

The docility of the animals, their natural curiosity, and their ability to mother were my top three points when I bought my first bred cow and heifer in 2015 at the NWSS. Little did I know how much those animals would impact how my husband and three little boys view cattle now.

Now, almost 10 years and three little shadows that frequent the cattle lots later, I've been amazed with the adaptability of our Galloways-how gentle and naturally curious they are with our boys. We do not have the quietest of kids, in fact they are quite rambunctious little men, and our Galloway cows never bat an eye. In fact, our oldest cow has been known to pick up our oldest in the gentlest of ways and start carrying him off across the pasture on adventures together while we were out fencing! It's also been neat to watch our new bull, who had never been around young kids, become curious and inquisitive about the little humans running around outside his pen during chore time. Not once has he spooked like other cattle our boys are nearby. Now, he may not be the biggest fan of them all the time, but he is warming up to them quite nicely. Obviously, you must be careful with kids and cattle, that's a given. But I couldn't ask for a better breed for our boys to grow up around and learn how to handle. Another positive is when our boys are old enough to show, the docility of the Galloway breed makes them much less intimidating for young showmen.

I am so grateful for my parents who encouraged me all those years ago in high school to write that research paper, and from that, the discovery of the Galloway breed for me and our small family.
